Thank you for your questions of 19 January 2022 on the implementation of the Directive (EU) 2019/633 on unfair trading practices ('the Directive').

In your email you ask whether drinks, such as water, spring water, soft drinks or flavoured table water would fall within the scope of the Directive.

According to Article 2 (1) of the Directive, the Directive covers products under Annex I TFEU as well as, products not listed in that Annex but processed from them for use as food. Since water is not an Annex I TFEU product, it does not fall under the scope of the Directive. This applies also to bottled water. Whether bottled water is considered food and intended for human consumption e.g under other legal frameworks, is not relevant for the application of the Directive, where the definition of Article 2(1) is applied.

With regard to soft drinks or flavoured table water, an assessment would have to be made if the product is made out of Annex I products. It will be the ingredients additional to water that would determine whether the product falls under the scope of the Directive.
